RE: COVID-19 concerns and requests

This serves to capture our discussions regarding COVID-19 concerns and requests for immediate remedy as follows:

- On March the March 18, 2020 COVID-19 Employee Directive from David Devine provided information regarding designation of essential v. non-essential employees. The Association was to be provided with the list and to date no list has been received. I understand the non-essential employees will now be called by to work, via telework accommodations when feasible. *Please provide an update on the designations and provide the Association with a list of represented classifications with designations and assigned work sites within 10 days.*
- Many employees were designated as essential and required to report to work. *The verbal request to provide retroactive hazard pay is reiterated here in writing.*
- Safety concerns continue to be reported and it is expected they will be immediately investigated and properly addressed. *The list of the concerns I shared with you include:* UV lights out at the Primary Care Center; Employees performing fit testing of PPE without protection; Inconsistent application of intermittent telework opportunities for essential employees.
